7.0 Transportation	David asked for a transportation update from WOAH. Laura stated that WOAH integrated Non-Emergent Medical Transportation (NEMT) services into our CCO contract October 1, 2105. As the CAC is aware, WOAH contracts with Translink as the Transportation Brokerage. John asked how Translink worked and if they had any local providers. Laura stated that both Bay Cities Ambulance and Yellow Cab are long-standing providers of Translink. Laura shared that we now have 6 months of financial data to look at to see if we are able to expand benefits to cover rides to such services as smoking cessation classes, WIC, DME pick up, etc. We currently provide our Care Management Team authority to approve transportation traditionally not covered for members in our Care Management Program who have special considerations. WOAH customer service and care management staff meet with Translink staff weekly to address issues as they come up. It's been a seamless translink was their contact prior to the CCO integrating NEMT. David wondered about ways that providers could go to the member's home. Florence indicated that home visits were typically the role of a Community Health Worker. Lisa shared that SWOCC currently does not have a certification program for Community Health Workers. Local
