| 6.0 CHIP Implementation | <i>Substance Abuse Prevention/ Behavioral Health Task Force</i> – First joint meeting of AllCare and WOA was held on November 20. Heather Hartman from AllCare and | | | |

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| | <p>Maggie Lowery from WOAHA attended along with Jan Barker from Curry Community Health. Group discussed available services in Curry County. Learned that Curry County has Level 1 Substance Abuse Treatment (Outpatient). No residential treatment available in Curry County.</p> <p>Dori's goal is to bring peer-delivered services to Curry. There is currently the Clubhouse drop-in center. CCH was awarded \$125,000 in prevention-based funds from 12-25 year olds. Focus is on alcohol and prescription drug abuse.</p> <p>The jail received a grant for one Mental Health group and one A/D group. There is also a problem gambling and domestic violence counseling in the jail.</p> <p>Working on developing a peer advisory committee that would meet at CCH in Brookings. AllCare has agreed to fund help from consultant Vanessa Becker to get the committee started.</p> <p><i>Healthy Food & Lifestyle Task Force</i> – Connie has been working on going into schools in Curry County and has found it to be challenging. She would like to develop a pamphlet with pictures of fruits and vegetables. Connie has talked to Dutch Bros. and Dollar Tree to find out if they can provide donations for this project. Connie would like to go into the middle schools and do taste testing on fruits and vegetables to see what the students like. Tamara suggested a dental program that also relates to nutrition called Healthy Kids Outreach Program. Hygienists bring in displays to teach students the effect of different foods on oral health. This program also contains tobacco education.</p> <p><i>School Based Health Services Task Force</i> – No updates from this group at this time.</p> <p><i>Linkages</i> – Group has decided to collaborate with AllCare.
