1.0 Call to Order	The meeting was called to order at 12:08pm by Patty Savage.			
2.0 Membership	Patty reported the CAC currently has 7 members. Two membership applications are in process and will be sent to the County Commissioners for approval. Applications are still being accepted.

4.0 Update From OHA	Kay Metzger followed up on the CAC Summit stating that everyone who attended has been invited to participate in an advisory committee related to accessibility issues due to challenges with the venue where the summit was held. A newsletter on the Health Systems Transformation Report shows that in the second year of CCOs there has been improvement in a number of key health outcomes.			
5.0 Oasis Shelter Home	Oasis can provide free training on trauma informed care relating to sexual assault, stalking, human trafficking and more.			
6.0 2014 Quality Incentive Measures	Ben Messner shared that this past year WOH met 12.8 out of 17 quality incentive measures, resulting in the			

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	return of 103% of the 3% gross revenue withhold. The purpose of the revenue withhold from CCOs is to create pay for performance, incentivizing providers to offer quality care			
7.0 Transportation	Laura Williams informed the CAC that WOAHA will be taking over transportation on October 1 st instead of August 1 st . Things are going smoothly as the management of volunteer drivers shifts from DHS to OHA and Translink. Dori Statton expressed concern that in the past it has been an issue to require the provider to sign a form for mile reimbursement; this is a quality issue as the program needs to ensure that people aren't claiming mileage for an appointment they didn't attend.			
8.0 CHIP Implementation Process	Oasis Shelter Home provided a copy of their resource guide which the CAC believe to be a good starting point in addressing the issue of linkages here in Curry County. A linkages taskforce was formed in order to identify what the CAC needs to include in its resource guide. Mental health and substance abuse will be the next focus areas after linkages.
