4.0 CHIP Sub-Committee	Suicide Prevention Eric Gleason provided an update on the objectives for the Suicide Prevention CHIP sub-committee. 1st objective: The committee has 3 groups to focus on, youth, Veterans and elderly. For youth suicide prevention they are looking at similar projects as in Lane and Klamath counties. They are looking at implementing a drop in center for teens. They will have peer-to-peer contact for any type of issues. This will be for school-aged kids 17 and under. Peers will be just a few years older that have been through similar situations. For elderly suicide prevention they will be looking for			

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	volunteers for companionship. These			
	volunteers would be going into the			
	nursing homes or personal homes to			
	spend time with the elderly, talking to			
	them, playing games etc. For Veteran			
	suicide prevention they will be			
	focusing on dual diagnosis, PTSD and			
	substance abuse. The committee will			
	be looking at programs in Lane county			
	to base this off of. In Lane county they			
	have activities set up for the Veterans			
	to participate in, such as photography,			
	gardening etc. The second objective
