## **Timeliness of Postpartum Care**

The Timeliness of Postpartum Care measure is a Quality Incentive Measure.

**Measure Description**: Percentage of pregnant women who received a postpartum care visit on or between 21 and 56 days after delivery.

## **Measure Specifications**

Data: Claims data and Chart Review

Benchmark: 69.3%

**Denominator:** All live birth deliveries from November 6, 2018 through November 5, 2019 for Advanced Health members who also meet the continuous enrollment criteria. OHA will identify the live birth deliveries from claims data and provide Advanced Health with a sample for chart review.

**Continuous Enrollment Criteria:** 43 days prior to the delivery date through 56 days after the delivery date.

**Numerator:** A postpartum visit for a pelvic exam or postpartum care on or between 21 and 56 days after delivery.

## **Prenatal Care**

The Prenatal Care measure is not incentivized but is reported publicly as a state performance measure.

**Measure Description:** Percentage of women with a prenatal care visit in the first trimester or within 42 days of enrollment.

Benchmark: 90.8%

Denominator: Same as for Postpartum Care, above.

Numerator: A first prenatal visit within the eligible timely window.

**Continuous enrollment criteria**: 43 days prior to the Estimated Date of Delivery (EDD) through 56 days after EDD.
