Application

Community Health Improvement Program (CHIP) Funding

To support the work of the Community Health Improvement Plans (CHIP) in Curry County, Advanced Health is offering funding up to \$2,500 to help support CHIP subcommittee for the calendar year 2019. The intended purpose of the funding is to assist in the achievement of a specific objective, strategy, or activity that falls under one of the new CHIP priority areas (listed below). Preference will be given to initiatives that can become self-sustaining and self-sufficient over time if proven to be successful.

Advanced Health CHIP grants will be funded based upon the following priority areas and will be submitted for approval by a CHIP subcommittee member or Advanced Health Community Engagement Team staff member to the Curry Community Advisory Council (CAC):

Curry County: Health Equity, Communities & Families, Youth, Health Systems & Capacity, Access to Healthcare, Oral Health, Behavioral Health & Addictions, Workforce Development & Economic Development, Food & Nutrition

To apply for funding, the CHIP subcommittee Chairperson, or designee, must submit a brief application to Advanced Health including the Project/Program Description, Outcomes/Goals, and Financials.

Timeline

All applications are due by November 30, 2019.

Decisions will be made within 30 days of the receipt of the application. Funds will be issued within 7 working days of the approval of the application.

Project / Program Description

- Explain the objective or strategy that the funding will support.
- Are there any other community partners who are supporting the work? If so, please list them and the type of support they are providing.

Outcomes / Goals

- In one or two sentences, state the outcome of the supported project that you would like to achieve.
- Explain how the supported project aligns with or supports CHIP activities.

Financials

- Identify and state the entity that will serve as the fiscal agent on behalf of the CHIP subcommittee.
- Include a basic line-item budget.

Reporting Requirements

- The outcome of your project should be documented in the CHIP subcommittee Work Plan and in the CHIP Subcommittee annual report.

Submit to Advanced Health Community Engagement Team

- Your application will be reviewed by the Advanced Health Community Engagement Team & the Curry CAC. If we have any questions, we will contact the applicant.
