

Community Capacity Building Funds

Grants to grow Oregon's health-related social needs provider network

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) provides <u>coordinated care organizations</u> (CCOs) with Community Capacity Building Funds (CCBF). CCOs administer this grant program. They award CCBF grants to community partners to help them become health-related social needs providers.

Health-related social needs (HRSNs) are social and economic needs that affect your ability to maintain health and well-being. HRSN benefits include:

- Housing
- Nutrition
- Outreach and engagement (help getting other benefits)

What can CCBF grants be used for?

There are four main categories that CCBF can be used for.

- Technology
- Business or operational processes
- Workforce development
- Outreach, education and convening

Who can apply for CCBF?

Organizations that are eligible to apply for CCBF grants must:

Intend to serve eligible members

- Have strong community relationships
- Intend to provide HRSN services in a way that is culturally and linguistically responsive, trauma informed and meets all requirements.

They must also be one of the following:

- Community-based organization
- Organization that provides or coordinates HRSN benefits
- Organization that supports the development of the HRSN network

How to apply

Organizations who would like to apply for CCBF grants need to contact their local CCO to apply. See the <u>Local Contacts for Community Capacity Building Funds webpage</u> for contact information.
